You Should Also Keep an Eye on the Process Itself and Final Accounting When Replacing Boilers Using Subsidies

- The Czech Gas Association warns applicants for boiler subsidies of their obligations throughout the process of the replacement of their environmentally unfriendly units;
- Because of mistakes in the statement of costs, Regions have already had to refuse to disburse subsidies to applicants who originally were successful;
- Gas companies have appealed to Regions to pay the invoices in arrears and to put in place a system of application lodging based that used by the Moravian-Silesian Region.

Prague, 18 October 2017 – Czechs are again making unnecessary mistakes in lodging their applications during the second wave of the boiler subsidies. This has transpired from the meeting of a technical discussion panel organised today by the Czech Gas Association (CGA) with representatives of certain Regions and gas companies. The experts have also pointed out some problems and risks entailed in boiler replacement and the final accounting. They referred to applications being lodged without the required documents, to people selecting incompetent installation firms, and failure to keep the required structure of cost breakdown, as some of the most frequent mistakes appearing in the three areas discussed.
