



Interest in CNG on the Rise in the Czech Republic

- The year-on-year increase is thousands of new vehicles and tens of CNG fuelling stations
- For further CNG development, long-term support by the government is crucial

Prague, 29 January 2018 – Compressed natural gas (CNG) demand rose by 13.9% year-on-year in the Czech Republic. According to the statistics of the Czech Gas Association (CGA) more than 67.6 million cubic metres of CNG were sold in the country in 2017. Almost 20,000 CNG vehicles are riding on Czech roads. In particular public municipal transport buses account for the largest share of CNG consumption. The network of CNG fuelling stations is continuously expanding and 172 of them are currently in operation.
